Step One

FOR EACH STATEMENT BELOW, check Y (yes) if the statement applies to the website and N (no/not sure) if the statement does not apply.

AUTH	HORITY/CREDIBILITY	Υ	N
1.	Is the site's author/producer clearly identified?		
2.	Does the site provide credentials for the author/producer?		
ACCI	URACY	Υ	N
1.	Is the information consistent with other resources on the topic?		
2.	Does the site provide references you can use to verify its accuracy?		
BIAS	OBJECTIVITY	Υ	N
1.	Does the site express more than one viewpoint or opinion?		
2.	Is the site free of advertising?		
TIMELINESS		Υ	N
1.	Does the site state when it was created/compiled?		
2.	Can you determine if the site has been updated recently?		
COVERAGE		Υ	N
1.	Does the site cover a time period appropriate for your topic?		
2.	Does the site cover your topic in enough depth for your needs?		
RELEVANCE/APPROPRIATENESS		Υ	N
1.	Does the site provide comprehensive information that is relevant to your topic?		
2.	Does the site direct its information at a level appropriate for your needs?
